- Solid timber: natural variation and strong character

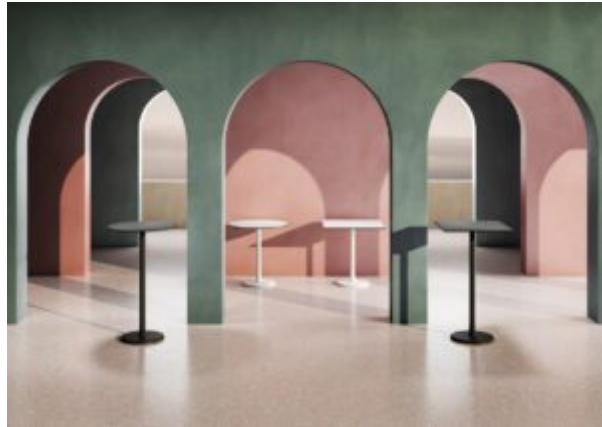
